Your itinerary

Monday, 15th August, 2016

Depart Sydney SYD 18:40 on VA183

Tuesday, 16th August, 2016

02:10 arrive *Nuku'alofa – Tonga*. (Total flight time, 4 hours, 30 minutes)

We will then wait in a comfortable hotel foyer nearby until we need to proceed to the domestic terminal.

07:30 depart *Nuku'alofa* on Real Tonga Airlines flight arrive *Vava'u* 08:40 (Total flight time; 1 hour, 10 minutes)

You will be transferred to your accommodation for 7 nights' standard, twin share accommodation including breakfasts.

Wednesday, 17th August to Monday, 22nd August, 2016

For everyone: Enjoy three days Whale Watching around the beautiful islands of Vava'u. These days are our opportunity to enjoy the privilege of snorkeling with Humpback Whales.

Light lunch, fruit platters & refreshments are enjoyed whilst anchored off white sandy beaches. There will be many opportunities for snorkelling over tropical reefs and in open sea caves in the crystal clear water. It all adds up to being the best days out on the water imaginable.

For SCUBA divers: Enjoy a 4-dive package including the use of tanks, weights, dive guide services, fruit, tea and coffee

For non-divers: Book another opportunity to snorkel with the Humpback Whales, this can be done, weather permitting, whilst you are there. You may wish to try some of the other options below or just relax and enjoy Vava'u

Other Optional Activities: Kayak and mountain bike hire

Sunday: By law Sunday is a day of rest. Going to one of the local churches on Sunday morning (not compulsory) is very special; this singing will be one of your fondest memories of Vava'u. On the Sunday afternoon we will enjoy a traditional Tongan feast and kava ceremony.

Tuesday, 23rd August, 2016

Today we bid a fond farewell to Vava'u and begin our journey home. We depart Vava'u around 08:00, arrive Tongatapu. (Total flight time; 1 hour)

Depart Tongatapu at 12:15, arrive Sydney at 15:00 hours. (Total flight time; 5 hours, 45 minutes)

Vava'u

Vava'u is an island group of one large island and 40 smaller islands in Tonga. Vava'u rises 204 metres above sea level at Mt Talau. The capital is Neiafu, and has a population of around 6000 people.

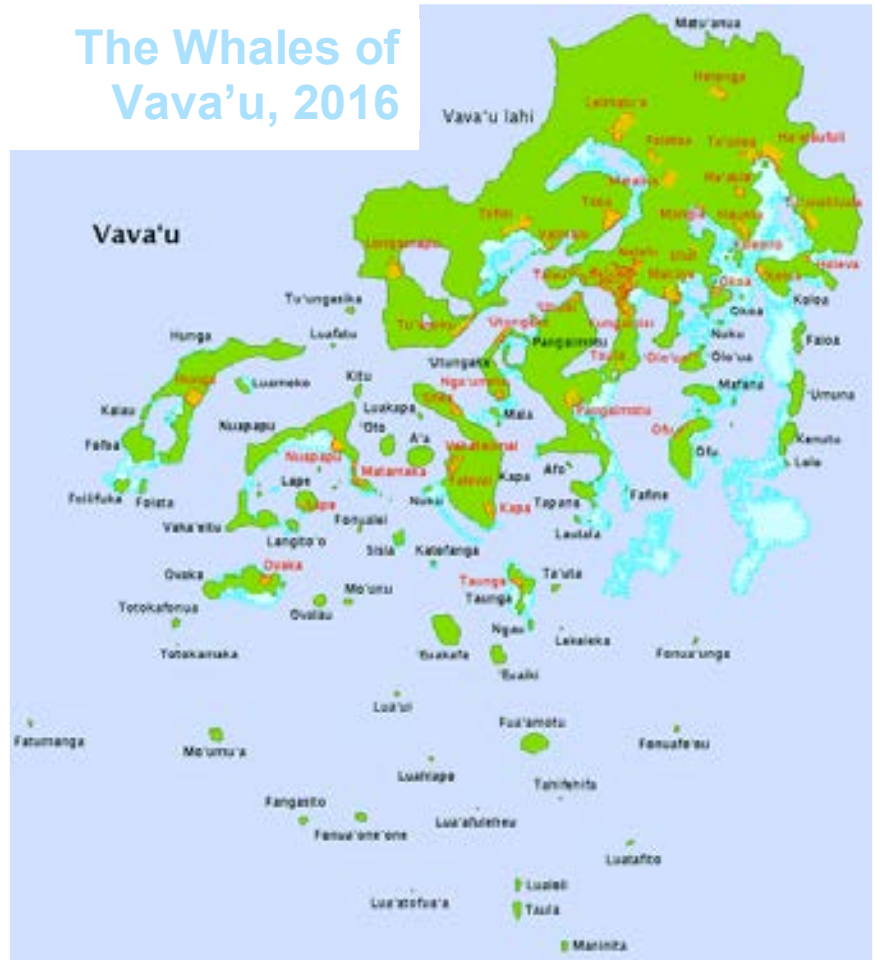
We will be operating out of the Port of Refuge harbour, which is one of the best, most protected harbours in the world.

The Vava'u Island group in the Kingdom of Tonga is a spectacular tropical island paradise in the Pacific Ocean. It has a year-round climate suitable for swimming, snorkeling, diving and sailing. Some islands are ringed by white sand beaches while others have tropical forests, sea-level caves, and dramatic limestone cliffs with breathtaking vistas.

Remote and truly unspoiled, the waters around Vava'u are crystal clear with visibility exceeding 30 metres. Most of the islands are uninhabited, a few have villages, a few have very small unique resorts with exceptional food. There is abundant sea life with over 100 species of colorful tropical fish, giant clams, manta rays, sea turtles, spinner dolphins, and July-October the Humpback whales!

Truly a paradise, with the only Polynesian Monarchy, this is a remarkable place to explore.

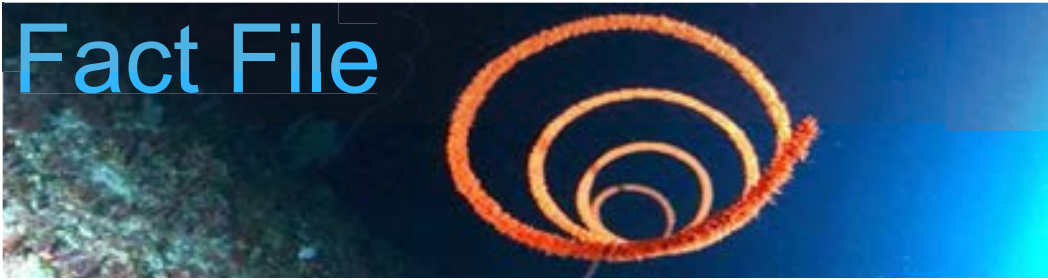
The resort is nestled on the beach front of the island of 'Utungake. There is safe swimming at all tides and a water taxi service to Neiafu and back.

This resort spans 180 metres of beachfront, with all rooms enjoying views of the golden sand beach and the Port of Refuge Harbour.

This resort is located out of town, and you will be picked up from the Resort's private jetty for Whale Swim days and SCUBA Diving.

Quest Tours – General Diving and Snorkelling Rules

Obviously on all dive and snorkelling tours, safety is our main concern. The quality of diving is guaranteed. Tonga has incredible reef diving, however, it is relatively remote compared to much of the developed world. The following guidelines will help you enjoy your tour and stay safe on your holiday

For Snorkellers

Good quality, well fitting snorkelling fins (not kick fins) are essential. A well-fitted mask that has been treated so it does not fog will keep you comfortable, and we strongly recommend a high-quality snorkel with a splashguard and a purge valve.

Please ask us for advice regarding all of this equipment. We have packages exclusively available for our tour participants at \$120.

Your guide on the tour will be trained for in-water rescues and emergency first aid.

For Divers

The use of a computer, octopus and SMB are mandatory. If you don't have these, let us know in advance and we will prepare them for you. There is some spare rental gear at the dive centre in Tonga, however we strongly recommend that you have your gear checked before the trip.

Bookings:

To book onto the tour you will need to supply a completed booking form, together with a photocopy of your passport and a \$1500 non-refundable deposit.

We have booked the whale watch and diving operation for the height of the whale watch season, early bookings are essential and will ensure your spot on the tour. Before booking please read thoroughly the **BOOKING CONDITIONS** as published on our websites.

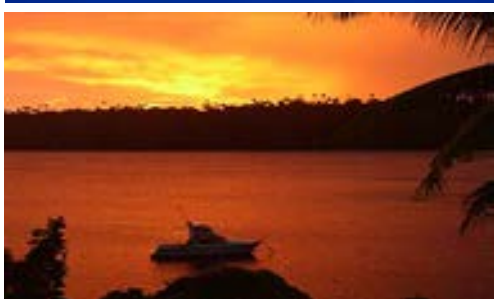

Travel Insurance

Travel insurance is compulsory on all of our tours. We strongly recommend taking out travel insurance at the same time as paying your deposit. SureSave, our recommended insurance provider, will cover you at the time of taking out your policy and until your tour's return date. We can arrange a quote for you, please let us know at the time of booking if you would like this.

We suggest carefully checking conditions of any other travel insurance you may be considering.

Please note that DAN Insurance does not cover you for things such as flight cancellations, lost baggage or similar. They only cover you for diving related injuries. We recommend and insist on additional, comprehensive insurance to cover cancellations, airline changes and baggage in conjunction with DAN.
